PS - It is with a sad heart that I announce that Jean Inge passed away earlier this week. Funeral arrangements are pending and will be announced as soon as they are available.




Sunday is the second Sunday of the month which is the day set aside for the Daughters of the King's




# PLEASE RSVP!!!


