A note from Ron Pierce: I recently completed the Safe Church training requirements for a member of the Bishop's Committee. My training involved 10 courses and I was able to

complete them in one evening. The Safe Church program establishes policy and protocol to safeguard the physical, emotional and spiritual health of all people. Special emphasis and focus is placed on protecting children, youth and vulnerable seniors. The courses are informative and easy to navigate. Most of the courses I completed contained presentations and testimonial videos from a variety of spiritual leaders. The Safe Church program not only identifies situations that require attention to safeguard our children, youth and vulnerable adults, but how to address the situations as well. This is a well built program. I'm grateful for the opportunity!

So, lets follow the example of our illustrious leader and get this done! In the words of Tiny Tim, "God Bless you every one."

WE NEED HELP to from you!








St. John's Outreach News and Needs

CAIR is in need of our help! Even though they have closed the resource center here, their work continues. They received a \$5000 grant from Mayflower Congregational UCC to purchase diapers and distribute them to Afghan neighbors along with educational materials on where to obtain free/low-cost diapers in the OKC metro area. How can you help in this effort?

- 1. **Make a financial donation** to supplement the Mayflower grant. The Mayflower grant will help in their initial goal to provide each child with 100 diapers. Additional funding would allow them to 1) buy newborn and size 1 diapers that The Spero Project can send home with parents for the next 40 new babies born and/or 2) provide each household with 2 packs of wipes to accompany the diapers.
- Volunteer to support Mayflower Congregational UCC in repackaging the
 diapers purchased in bulk and to help deliver diapers in late-June. Jen will send out
 a SignUp Genius the last week of May which will be passed on to you in this
 missive.
