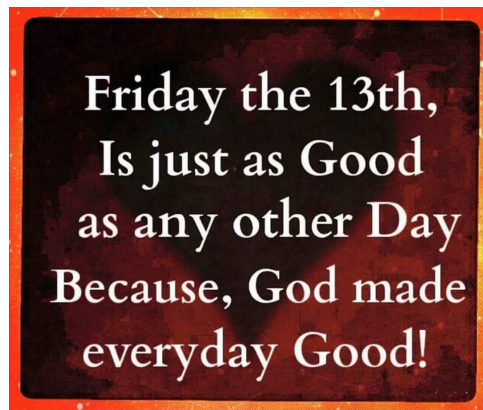

To download, you will see a symbol (a downward arrow) in the lower right corner of the photo. Click on that symbol and you will then see the photo you have chosen pop up on a new page. Scroll down to the bottom of that page, right side, and click on "Download Image."

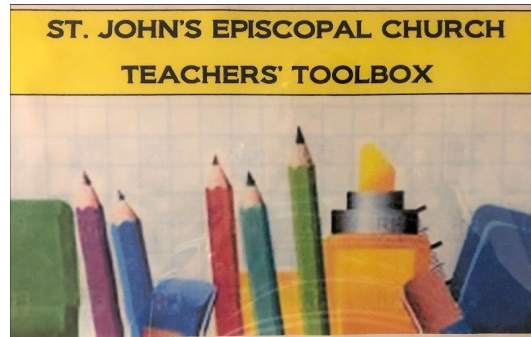
