

I was watching them move furnishings in through the school doors yesterday and it was kind of like an ant parade. Those guys were lugging and hauling stuff in, building a better school at St. John's. You will hear great things about this project as they work quickly to prepare their spaces in time to start classes on August 21. Our prayers are with the Crum family, teachers and all involved in this swift makeover of St. John's school annex.
