In other words, Jesus's prediction and warning to his disciples about the persecution, people giving up or looking for the end of his community, is accurate. According to the haters, we should not have a church. The Church has been criticized from the beginning, and its failure has often been predicted.

From the beginning, Church has struggled. Every time that happens, people predict the end of the Church.

However, still today, we have Church. We are here today, celebrating and believing. Why?

C. Today's Gospel Perspective:

I believe the question is not when the Church will finally disappear. Instead, the question should be why we still have Church. We have Church for three reasons: in Peter's confession, in Jesus's revelation of the divine power behind Peter's (OUR) faith, and in Jesus's promises to his Church.

- You are the "SON OF THE LIVING GOD"
- In Peter, we have received the secret power of the Highest."
- And finally, in Peter, we, the authority over any other power".

That is why we still have Church: In the confession and revelation of the Living Son of God.

That is why we should fight for Justice, especially against poverty and Death Penalty.

That is why we should fight for diversity and against racism.

WE HAVE THE POWER OF THE LIVING SON OF GOD. That is why Church always will exist. There is no other Kingdom or Gospel.
